SUMMER CAMP PACKING LIST

Guideline to plan for your week at camp. The Scoutmaster may have additional suggestions.

Official BSA Uniform:

- Boy Scout Handbook
- Short Sleeve Shirt (khaki)
- Shorts/Pants (BSA green)
- Scout belt
- Scout socks (2 pair)
- Neckerchief w/slide

Clothing (mark your clothing with permanent marker to avoid confusion, if possible):

- T-Shirts (class B or any other t-shirt so long as it is non- offensive) - 6
- Underwear - 6
- Shorts (cargo style w/pockets work best) - 4
- Long pants (scout pants with zip off legs work best)
- Socks – 7 pairs
- Sweatshirt/jacket
- Rain gear (poncho or rain jacket)
- Sleepwear
- Sneakers
- Hiking boots
- Water shoes/old sneakers for wading (NO OPEN TOED shoes)
- Bathing suit and towel
- Hat w/brim

Bedding:

- Camp supplies a tent with a cot (2 scouts per tent)
- Sleeping bag (lightweight) and/blankets
- Pillow and pillow case
- Flat sheet for warm nights

Camping Gear:

- Footlocker/backpack/suitcase (something that will keep clothes dry and off the floor)
- Flashlight with extra batteries
- Pocket knife – if permitted by Scoutmaster
- Water bottle/canteen/hydration pack (something that can be refilled, water is always available but containers are not).
- Camp chair
- Dirty laundry bag

Toiletries:

- Soap in a case or zip-lock bag
- Shampoo (travel size will save some space)
- Towel
- Washcloths – 2
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Comb
- Flip flops for shower
- Tissues
- Shaving cream and razor (if scout shaves)

Other items:

- Insect repellent (non-aerosol)
- Merit Badge Pre-requisite work
- Notebook w/ pen
- Pocket Knife
- Wristwatch
- Mosquito Netting
- Sunscreen
- Sunglasses
- Spending money \$20-40 (for trading post and lunch on the way back)

Optional Items:

- Camera (disposable)
- Book to read
- Playing Cards
- Mess kit

What NOT to bring:

- Sheath knives
- Axes or saws
- Fireworks
- Firearms, BB guns or Ammunition
- Cell phones
- Beepers
- Electronic devices/games
- Portable radios and/or CD players
- Pets
- Unscout-like literature
- Non-prescription medicine
