### **Dear Parents and Scouts of Troop 272:**

Our 49<sup>th</sup> Annual Tree Sale is about to commence! The proceeds of the tree sale fund troop advancement awards, the troop charter, various capital expenditures (like camping equipment and first aid kits), and significantly subsidizes summer camp costs for everyone who participates. Engagement from all scouting families is necessary for the success of the sale. As the saying goes, "many hands make light work." This is also a great opportunity for all of our scouts to join together to make sure that our annual fundraiser gets off to a good start.

The Troop Committee stresses that this is a **required activity** for every scout and his parent(s).

### **Key Dates & Support Needed:**

- Wednesday, November 10, Permission Slip Due (see attached)
- Saturday November 20, 8-11am, Lot Set-Up (bring rake, gloves & mask)
- Sunday, November 28, 7-9am, Tree Delivery
- November 28 December 24, Sale Shifts (varies per scout; see "Shift Scheduling" below)

#### **Shift Scheduling:**

Due to COVID safety concerns, we are again requiring that one parent accompany their scout at each shift to assist in any close contact activities (e.g., tying trees to top of cars, re-stocking the tree stands, etc.). We have modified the schedule this year in several ways to hopefully make this easier for each family to accommodate. In order to create a schedule that is convenient for as many as possible, you must notify Mr. Epp (tomepp@comcast.net) no later than Wednesday, November 10 with dates that you are UNAVAILABLE to work. E-mail messages are the only acceptable means for this communication.

After the schedule is set it will be *your* responsibility to find a replacement should your schedule change and you become unavailable. We ask that you also switch with someone of comparable physical capabilities to help with tree lifting, etc.
