- Parental Supervision is necessary for these events and participation in **one event is required as a parent**. You will be required to sign-in to record your participation. Two adults are required to accompany each group of scouts for each assigned location.
- This Adopt-A-Highway service event does NOT count as the service time requirement for advancement. These events are our way to give back to our Chartered Organization, the Rose Valley Folk.
